NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND INTENT TO ADOPT AN IMPACT FEE ORDINANCE FOR PARKS, RECREATION AND PUBLIC PROPERTIES, PUBLIC SAFETY (FIRE & POLICE), ROADWAY, CULINARY WATER AND POWER.

Kaysville City, a municipal corporation of the State of Utah, located in Davis County, pursuant to the requirements of Utah Code Ann. sections 11-36a-504 and 10-9a-205, hereby gives notice of its intent to adopt an impact fee ordinance for parks, recreation and public properties, public safety, culinary water, roadway and power. The proposed Impact Fee(s) are based on Kaysville City's Impact Fee Facilities Plan and corresponding Impact Fee Analysis.

Kaysville City will hold a Hearing on February 21, 2019 at 6:30 P.M. The Hearing will be held at Kaysville City Offices 23 East Center Street, Kaysville, Utah.

The purpose of the Hearing is to receive input on, and consider approval and adoption of the proposed Impact Fee Ordinance. All interested persons will be given reasonable opportunity to be heard. Copies of the Impact Fee Analysis, and corresponding Ordinance will be available for public review beginning Monday, February 11, 2019.
